Since opening the Sacramento Melting Pot in 2003 we have always looked for ways to control cost while at the same time supporting the environment. Over the years we have tested and implemented many different products and services. From Low Temp dishwashers, LED lighting, Waste Recycling to IONized cleaning and many more.

Most recently we had Building RX install a *HydroFLOW* S38 unit. The aim of the unit was to eliminate scale, bacteria and algae forming in our water system. The benefits included no impact to water taste, no water softener required and all water (hot, cold and drinking) benefiting from the one unit. Thus reducing maintenance and cleaning requirements of our dishwasher, ice machine and coffee machines. It was very important to us to ensure our glassware, dishes and flatware were at least as clear/clean as before with the old water softener. In conjunction with a no-cost change in our rinse agent we have been able to meet this goal.

Our investment in the *HydroFLOW* S38 was less than \$1000 which we expect to save in just over 14 months by not using a water softener. Not only will we save money but we will also reduce our water usage.
